We are all aware of the bad bug season upon us. What to use that is safe for our pets is on everyones minds. There are some natural remedies that can be used that are safe for us, kids and pets.

APPLE CIDER VINEGAR: LEMON: NEEM OIL: are among them.

1**Apple cider Vinegar is one that is probably the cheapest. ACV has been long used in treatment for many dog & cat problems. ACV provides a rich & natural source of potassium, phosphorus, sodium, calcium, iron and minerals. A bug does not want to bite into a healthy dog that has alkaline in their blood. **Good pet food is the start of good health.** Your pet must be healthy from the inside out FIRST- so do not use these remedies in place of good food, vet care and much needed vaccinations.

ACV can be used for a **POOR APPETITE.** By putting a tablespoon in the meal, or on paws, the paw trick is to get them to ingest the ACV. if they are picky and don't like the taste of vinegar..

Put ACV in a spray bottle for itchy skin or hot spots. Part the pets hair and spray on. if the skin is broken or sore, dilute 1/2 to 1/2, and in 24 hrs, the sore should dry up.

ACV will keep your pets internal ph balance in check, which is critical for care of parasites, ring worm, fungus, mange, bacteria and many other ailments.

LEMON'S: Steep lemons for a few hours and let sit overnight. This can used just

like the ACV. above. but you don't put in their food or on paws. This is a wonderful remedies for keeping mositos from biting, flies, fleas. Put in a sprat bottle and spray on each morning or after a bath, rain, or snow. You can put a clean towel in the lemon water and wipe your pet down with it. I've never a dog being bitten with any of these methods. Rinsing your dog with warm water and lemon after a bath is as good as the ACV.

NEEM OIL: Has long been a natural pesticide in other countries. It is safe for the food supple, kids and pets. And smells great. NEEM OIL, can be sprayed or wiped on your pet. I have several NEEM OIL SHAMPOOS and Straight NEEM OIL. that I take with me. Not always having the ACV or lemons on hand, neem is an easy item to carry and take on trips as well as keep at home.



The more natural and healthful remedies we use on our pets, the better off they will be. Don't forget to check your dog and cats for ticks that hide in their coat after they have been outdoors. Get your pet used to you running your hands along all parts of them to make it easier to check for ticks. The ticks are so small and love to hide, so a good brushing daily in the summer, monthly baths, and handling will help assure your pet is tick free. We all want happy pets jumping for joy instead of chewing and itching all day and night.
